

RESOLUTION 2001-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BROWARD COUNTY FIRE RESCUE SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Southwest Ranches is a newly incorporated municipality within Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Southwest Ranches has been invited to join the City of Weston, the Town of Lauderdale-By-The-Sea, the Town of Pembroke Park and others in advising the Board of County Commissioners on fire protection and emergency medical services matters; and

WHEREAS, as a Broward County Fire Rescue Service community, the Town is entitled to appoint an elected official, or the Town's chief executive, to the Broward County Fire Rescue Services Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches desires to appoint a representative to the Broward County Fire Rescue Services Advisory Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:

Section 1: The above referenced recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2: The Town Council hereby appoints the Vice Mayor, Johnny Dollar, to the Broward County Fire Rescue Services Advisory Board.


