

**RESOLUTION NO. 2002-6**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES,  
FLORIDA REQUESTING BROWARD COUNTY TO DONATE SIXTY-  
EIGHT THOUSAND (68,000) CUBIC YARDS OF FILL THAT COUNTY  
INTENDS TO DECLARE SURPLUS PROPERTY.**

**WHEREAS**, the County has declared Sixty-eight Thousand (68,000) cubic yards of fill as surplus property from the Long Pine Key Natural Area and said fill is not needed at any other County site; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town has requested that the County donate this fill for the development of the Sunshine Ranches Equestrian Park Site; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 274.06, Florida Statutes, the County is authorized to declare such fill surplus property and make such a donation; and

**WHEREAS**, it is determined to be in the best interest of the County to dispose of the surplus fill by donation to the Town of Southwest Ranches and that this donation serves a public purpose and promotes community interest and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:


**Section 1:** The recitals set forth in the preamble to this Resolution are incorporated by reference herein.

**Section 2:** The Town agrees that the requested sixty- eight thousand (68,000) cubic yards of fill shall be used as follows:


- a. Town agrees that the fill material shall be used exclusively for and remain at the designated Sunshine Ranches Equestrian Park, a neighborhood park site.
- b. Town agrees to monitor any hauling contractor and certify to County that only sixty-eight thousand (68,000) cubic yards of loose, uncompacted fill material has been removed from the County site and hauled to the designated site only.
- c. Town agrees that any hauling activities must be completed within One Hundred Eighty (180) days of execution of the County's donation Resolution.
- d. Town agrees to be responsible for acquiring any and all required permits for the hauling of the fill material and for the payment of any associated costs and fees.

**Section 3:** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption


