

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY ("LMS") ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, requires the Town to plan for hazard mitigation, hurricane evacuation, post-disaster development planning and a local mitigation strategy; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Community Affairs ("DCA") has designated the Broward County Emergency Management Division as the local coordinator of the Local Mitigation Strategy Program for the Broward County area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Southwest Ranches will enter into an agreement with Broward County and the DCA to authorize the County to prepare the Town's municipal components of a single, unified County-wide Local Mitigation Strategy; and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Broward County adopted the Broward County Local Mitigation Strategy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The Town Council of The Town Of Southwest Ranches.

Section 1: That the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida hereby supports Broward County's adopted Local Mitigation Strategy.


Section 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


