

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-66

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHWEST RANCHES, FLORIDA ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE GREENWAY TRAILS SYSTEM; COMMITTING THE TOWN COUNCIL TO INCLUDE THE PROPOSED GREENWAY TRAILS IN THE TOWN'S PENDING FIRST COMPREHENSIVE PLAN'S FIVE (5) YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the staff of the Town, the Town Citizen Advisory Committee for the Comprehensive Plan, the South Florida Trail Riders and surrounding residents have met and agreed that it is necessary to create a comprehensive multi-use Greenway trail system to link the Town's outdoor open space and recreation areas together; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council recognizes the importance of identifying the funding to construct the new Greenways multi-use trails in the Town's five-year capital improvement schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Florida:


Section 1: The Town of Southwest Ranches hereby adopts Exhibit "A," Comprehensive Trail System Map.

Section 2: All Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 3: If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
