May 2017 Monthly Report

Parks

Country Estates Fishing Hole Park: The Town was awarded a \$50,000 FRDAP Grant to construct one multi-use sports field. The Aster Knights Park Foundation donated \$20,000 for the improvement. Weekley Asphalt Paving Inc. began work on May 25th. Work must be completed before July 4th, 2017.



Calusa Corners Park: The Town has \$100,000 in FRDAP grants from the State with no required Town match for construction of a pavilion, playground and parking improvements. Construction is underway.



Gary Poliakoff Founder's Pavilion: Construction of the sidewalk and pavilion is underway. Work must be completed before September 21, 2017.



Rolling Oaks Barn Storage Room: PHI Construction submitted the permit application to construct the storage room enclosure in the Rolling Oaks Barn.

Roads & Drainage

Transportation Surface and Drainage Ongoing Rehabilitation Program (TSDOR): The Town received five (5) bids on March 21st. After reviewing the bids, it was determined that Florida Construction and Engineering Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder that met the requirements of IFB 17-002. The Town Council awarded the contract to resurface all the roads listed in the bid beginning October 1st.



SW 54th Place Drainage Project: The South Broward Drainage District is currently designing the drainage improvements between SW 195th Lane and Frontier Trails Park. Drawings are approximately 95% complete.

Dykes Road Drainage: The South Broward Drainage District is currently designing the project. This project was in part by both the South Florida Water Management District and the South Broward Drainage District. Drawings are approximately 75% complete.

Stirling Road Guardrail: The Town was awarded \$300,000 from the State of Florida to install guardrails between the edge of pavement of Stirling Road and the canal bank from SW 142nd Avenue to SW 148th Avenue and between SW 136th Avenue to the 12600 block of Stirling Road (approximately 4,200 linear feet total). Surveying is completed and design is 50% complete.

Entranceway Signs: Staff has submitted permit applications to Broward County and South Florida Water Management District for two new entranceway signs along Griffin Road: one near Dykes Road and the other near Bonaventure Boulevard.

State Appropriations Request: Staff submitted appropriation requests to the state via the Town's lobbyist. The House and Senate approved the following projects, which now need the approval of Governor Scott: \$340,000 for drainage; \$200,000 for Griffin Road streetlights; \$375,000 for guardrails along Hancock Road, and \$300,000 for an emergency operations center.
