



## Projects

**Dykes Road Drainage:** Construction of the drainage improvement along Dykes Road and through Calusa Corners Park is underway.

**DEP Funded Drainage Projects:** Surveying and design has been completed (with the exception of Dykes Road Improvements) for the following drainage projects. The Dykes Road Improvement segment is currently under design. Construction is anticipated to begin in the fall.

- Construct catch basin adjacent to 5501 SW 136th Avenue (Holatee Trail) with associated piping and headwall structure connecting to the Central Broward Water Control District (CBWCD) S-33 Canal on the east side of Holatee Trail.
- Upgrade culverts and restoration of eastside swale along Dykes Road from Huntridge Drive to Calusa Corners Park with new underdrain and headwall connections at SW 51<sup>st</sup> Manor, SW 53<sup>rd</sup> Court, SW 54<sup>th</sup> Place and SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street. New outfalls will connect to the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD) Canal.
- Install catch basins and associated piping at the intersection of SW 54th Place and SW 188th Avenue, connecting westward to the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD) No. 12 Canal.
- Grade swales and install drainage pipe to connect an existing catch basin on SW 178<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 46<sup>th</sup> Street to the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD) Rolling Oaks Lateral Canal.
- Install catch basins and associated piping at the SW 201<sup>st</sup> Avenue cul-de-sac, connecting to the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD) Canal.

**Green Meadows Drainage Project:** The Town has been allocated funding from the State for the Green Meadows Drainage Project. An agreement will be on an upcoming Town Council Agenda.

**Transportation Surface and Drainage Ongoing Rehabilitation Program (TSDOR) for 2018 Construction:** Resurfacing is completed on Appaloosa Trail and Melaleuca Road. The swales and sodding will be completed soon. Resurfacing of SW 130<sup>th</sup> Avenue, SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street, and SW 128<sup>th</sup> is underway.

**Transportation Surface and Drainage Ongoing Rehabilitation Program (TSDOR) for 2019 Construction:** Surveying has been completed and design is underway for the FY 2019 construction project.

**Entranceway Signs:** Staff has submitted a permit application to Broward County for the new entranceway sign along Griffin Road near Bonaventure Boulevard. Broward County Board of County Commissioners approved the Revocable License Agreement.

**Fire Modular Replacement:** The Certificate of Occupancy was issued on July 27<sup>th</sup>. The skirting and striping work remains.

**Frontier Trails Park Improvements:** This project consists of installing a picnic pavilion, sidewalk, and parking improvement at the undeveloped Frontier Trails Park. Surveying has been completed and design is underway.

**Town Hall Parking Lot:** Staff has coordinated with Winningham & Fradley, Inc. to update the existing Town Hall Site Plan. The Site Plan is going to be phased to split up the project and assist with bidding.

**Roadway Maintenance Contract:** Staff is drafting the bid documents for roadway maintenance. The currently contract with Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. expires in November.

#### **ADVISORY BOARDS:**

**Comprehensive Plan Advisory Board (CPAB):** The Board meets on the third Thursday of each month. The next meeting will be August 16, 2018.

**Drainage and Infrastructure Advisory Board (DIAB):** The Board meets on the first Wednesday of each month. The next meeting will be August 1, 2018.

#### **OPERATIONAL:**

**Dykes Road Catch Basins:** Twenty-four the catch basins along Dykes Road were cleaned out.

**Nursery Zoning in Progress:** Staff is working with the Comprehensive Plan Advisory Board and the Drainage and Infrastructure Advisory Board to provide recommendation to the Town Council regarding nurseries within the Town.
